Agenda:

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:16 p.m.
- 2. Approve minutes of the February meeting. On a motion by Thiersten and seconded by Sara, minutes were approved.
- Thiersten reported that the Doubletree Hotel will actually cost \$9800, well beyond the budget of the Commission. Joe called the Radisson, but it will cost only slightly less. The CSUS Redwood Room is booked for May 21st, but Joe reserved it for May 28th. Rachel reported that the decorator is booked for May.
- 4. The Commission decided that May 28th is not a good date because it is Memorial Day weekend. After much debate, June 18th was decided on as a new date. Because the date is changed, Cindy will meet with Erica

- to see if Cal Expo is available, and Joe will check with other community centers. An additional meeting will be held March 28th at 6:15 to decide on the location.
- Commissioners debated about whether or not to try to use a professional decorator (who would hopefully work pro bono). Rachel said she will look at the decorator's designs to see if it is worth it.
- 6. Wristbands are expensive and require only 4 weeks delivery, so the Commission will wait to see if there is enough money leftover to order them. Slogans were brainstormed, and "think." and "____ my anti-drug" were the most popular.
- 7. New activities brochures will go to print as soon as Joe receives the pictures of new boardmembers next week.
- 8. Christine attended the Youth Development Leadership Academy. She learned about planning an event and emphasized that we should go over who, what, where, *why*, and when.
- 9. Sara suggested using MySpace for advertising our event. MySpace is similar to an online blog. Amanda will set up the MySpace page.
- 10. Joe called Friday Night Live to ask for partnership in the Teen Safe Night. They were interested but mentioned that the Attorney General holds a similar event at Waterworld. The Commission should be careful not to conflict with that event.
